Can you believe it? We are in our sixth year as Mount Horeb House Ministries. God is so good! He is allowing us to use our gifts, talents and experiences over the years to help bring healing to those who are hurting. We are His vessels—a truth which keeps us looking to Him rather than to ourselves.

Since mid-February we have ministered to 40 clients for a total of 177 sessions or 360 hours. Most of the people we work with are Christians. Some of the issues we have encountered are: anxiety disorders, depression, sexual abuse, dissociative identity disorders, marriage difficulties, addiction to alcohol and drugs, grief, parental conflict, and career changes. Only a fourth of these clients were able to pay for our services. By your faithful contributions

through Commission to Every Nation we were able to continue our ministry.
