Over the past year we have spent many hours looking for a place to expand the ministry. Wells Fargo Bank has agreed to lease us Suite 321 in the Wells Fargo building at Five Points here in Kerrville. No, it’s not the retreat center on 10 acres that I have dreamed about for years, but it is a place where we can triple the number of people with whom we can minister.

I knew that we could not afford much in the way of rent. They are leasing us the suite for \$12.00 a year. That was not a type-o. We needed about \$10,000 to remodel, for furnishings, and to purchase office equipment. We were amazed, thankful and affirmed when we received a donation to cover that cost. We still need about \$6,200 a month to cover ministry and operating expenses for 2009.

Yes, financial times are tough. But with

tough times comes greater opportunity for people to experience healing. It is very important for us to partner together in the restoration of lives. Your prayers and gifts give hope to many who are in despair. We need your help in this endeavor. Please consider making an investment in the work our Father continues to do through Mount Horeb House.
